- Check-in time is 8-10 p.m. at the Camp Office (room assignments only).
- Families will register during Monday's scheduled registration time. Northland does not provide Sunday supper.

### Discounts

- Early Bird Discount! \$50 off total camp price per family for registrations postmarked by March 15.
- Pastoral Discount—10% off a pastor's camp cost, per family attending from his church, will be applied at registration. (Example: If two families from his church attend camp, he would receive a 20% discount.)
- NI Alumni Discount—10% off total camp price (excluding Family 2)
- Maximum Family Charge—\$1,700

### Family Camp Financial Information

- If a family cancels 30 or more days before camp begins, all payments are refunded excluding a \$50 withholding fee. If the cancellation is made less than 30 days before camp begins, a \$75 withholding fee is retained. If the cancellation is made less than two weeks before camp begins, the entire \$100 registration fee is retained.
- An invoice for the balance is issued upon receipt of each payment. Paying the balance in full before arrival helps expedite the registration process upon a family's arrival at camp.
- The Pastoral Discount may be applied to the senior pastor or divided among the senior, associate, or youth pastors.
- Only ONE discount per family (in addition to the Early Bird discount).

#### Accommodation Options

All facilities include private bathrooms, bunk beds, and carpeted floors.  
 One married couple per room.

Our Pioneer Village cabins and center court rooms ("Lakeside" & "Timberside" cabins) include air-conditioning. There is a \$75 charge for these rooms. If you wish to reserve one of these rooms, please check here  (first come, first served).

#### Option 1

The center court cabins ("Lakeside" & "Timberside" cabins) provide centrally located rooms close to the Dining Hall, Chapel, Rec. Hall, and main activity area. Each room houses up to 10 people. These rooms are convenient for large families with small children. There is an additional \$75 charge for these rooms.

#### Option 2

The Marnie Patz Residence Hall is located 100 yards from the main activity area. Each room houses up to five people (mattresses are available upon request for extra family members). Facilities include a public kitchen, vending machines, and a handicapped-accessible room.

#### Option 3

For more private housing, the Paul Patz Residence Hall is located beside the gym and approximately 200 yards from the main campground. Each room comfortably houses five people (mattresses are available upon request for extra family members). Facilities include a public kitchen and vending machines.

### Option 4

Our Pioneer Village family cabins are situated across Camp Lake from the main campsite. Rooms are air-conditioned/heated with a loft, an oversized bathroom, and bunk beds for up to 14 people (minimum of six people required for each room; one married couple per room). This is a nice option for families who bring along bicycles or who enjoy a little extra walking. There is an additional .75 charge for these rooms.

Note: Housing is based on availability and on a first-come, first-served basis. Though every effort is made to honor requests, a specific room cannot be guaranteed. Only one family per room.

## EXTRA CAMP COSTS

## DRESS

- **Guys:** For daily activities, tank tops are not permitted, and shorts must reach the tops of the knees. The attire for evening services is pants and a collared shirt.
- **Girls:** All clothing worn for daily activities must reach the tops of the knees. Loose-fitting pants are acceptable for recreation. The attire for evening services is knee-length skirts or dresses. One-piece swimsuit or shorts/dark t-shirts are appropriate for water activities.

*Please Note: Northland maintains conservative standards for dress and conduct. We reserve the right to request a change in any clothing or behavior we deem inappropriate.*

## HOUSING

- Housing is determined before arrival.
- We divide housing into two categories: 7th–9th graders and 10th–12th graders.
- Up to three campers from one church may room together.

## WHAT TO BRING

Twin-sized sheets or sleeping bag, pillow, towels, health and beauty items, variety of clothing for warm and cool weather, extra clothes, tennis shoes (for rugged activities), one-piece swimsuit, jacket, Bible, notepad, pen, spending money, camera, flashlight, alarm clock, fan, insect repellent.

## WHAT TO LEAVE AT HOME

Cigarettes, tobacco, firearms, alcohol, skateboards, scooters, roller blades, bicycles, magazines, fireworks, nonprescription drugs, TVs, radios, iPod/CD/MP3 players, iPads, all electronic games and devices, cell phones, smart phones, laptops.

## HEALTH AND SAFETY

Our program is planned with health and safety as priorities. A full-time registered nurse is available 24 hours a day, and certified lifeguards supervise all water activities. Over-the-counter medication is provided by our Health Center. Please do not send medication unless it is prescribed by a doctor. Please keep all medication in its original, labeled containers. For the health and safety of all campers, we request that campers who have contagious conditions or diseases not attend camp. We appreciate your cooperation and understanding in this matter of public health.

## LOST AND FOUND

Mark all your belongings. Lost items that are not requested within two weeks of your week of camp are discarded. Requested items will be mailed at your expense.

## A NOTE TO PARENTS

Use of camp telephones or cell phones by campers is prohibited. Emergency calls will be directed through the Camp Office. Calls concerning safe arrival at Camp should be made by a sponsor from the group. Please send mail to campers using their name, church name, and the date of the camp week they are attending.
